They made it over the border into Austria just a couple hours before a neighbor who had been a spy for the authorities reported them leaving. Although they had to leave everything behind, and keep this secret from even their families,

in February of 1985, Suzie's family was accepted, and arrived in Canada, for the first time reaching freedom.



Those \$20 in "CPL math" is equivalent to 180 BIBLE STUDIES that each CPL hired native lay missionary holds on a MONTHLY basis!!!! ver the last few months we have continually asked the union and conference administrators what they feel their greatest need is in those communist countries respective to their territories The resounding response, though stated in different languages is: "PLEASE, RELATE TO THOSE CPL FAITH PARTNERS THAT URGENT NEED FOR FUNDS THAT WILL ALLOW US TO HIRE MORE NATIVE LAY MISSIONARIES hey know their territories and people know them.
